



Family of Samuel Rose Parkinson and Maria Hayter Smart

SAMUEL ROSE PARKINSON was born April 12, 1831, in Barrowford, Lancashire, England, the son of William Parkinson and Charlotte Rose. He lived with his family in Australia and Chile from 1839 to 1845. He returned to England for three years before migrating to St. Louis, Missouri in July 1848, where he was baptized Jan. 23, 1850 in Chouteau Pond where Union Station now stands. He arrived in Utah Sept. 23, 1854, and settled in Kaysville for six years. He aided the handcart company, helped relocate the Saints from Ft. Lemhi, Idaho and served against Johnston's Army. In 1860 he was a leader with Thomas Sharratt Smart in founding Franklin, the first permanent town in Idaho. Here Samuel was Bishop's First Counselor for thirty years in the same Bishopric. He was Stake Patriarch for twenty-seven years. A farmer, stockman, freighter, merchant, he helped establish the first woolen mills, and with Brother Smart the first sawmill in Idaho. Feb 15, 1868, he was married to Maria Hayter Smart by Daniel H. Wells. Earlier marriages were to Arabella Chandler and to Maria's older sister, Charlotte.

MARIA was born in St. Louis, Missouri, April 29, 1851, the year her family heard and accepted the gospel. Her parents, Thomas Sharratt Smart and Ann Hayter, natives of England, had met and married in France before emigrating to St. Louis in 1845. After joining the Church they came to Utah, arriving in Salt Lake Sept. 4, 1852. They lived first in American Fork, then Provo, where Maria was baptized in 1859. Her family moved to Franklin in 1860.

Samuel and Maria had thirteen children. Five sons and five daughters grew to maturity. Coming from a large family and rearing a large family under challenging pioneer conditions, Maria was a capable, devoted wife and mother, learning thrift, generosity, and neighborliness through service to friends and family and to all in need. Her role as Good Samaritan endeared her to everyone. The family moved to Preston and Logan for school and temple opportunities. Maria died at 64, July 15, 1915, in Logan, Utah. Samuel died at 88 on May 23, 1919, in Preston, Idaho. Both are buried in the Franklin Cemetery.
